Bull Pot Farm Emergency Rapid First Response Kit 2011

This kit is kept at BPF for use in an emergency situation. There are a few simple items in one sack intended for rapid deployment to the casualty to assist in some basic first aid and to keep the casualty and those assisting the casualty warm whilst waiting for CRO to arrive. This poster is intended to show the contents and explain the use. Do not hesitate to use the kit but do not let its use hinder the need to call for the help of CRO.

This poster shows the items in the sack and the use for which they are intended.

This kit should not be a substitute for any personal survival kit you should carry.

There are no medications or drugs of any kind kept in here.

Take time to learn the full CRO call out procedure before you need it.

These items will be checked by CRO on a routine basis. Please do not open the sealed sack or disturb the contents unless they need to be used.

Contents in one sack



6 Man Bivi Shelter. Very useful as a simple tent for keeping casualty and companions warm.



Lightweight Sleeping Bag plus balaclava and foam mat.



Splinting Straps.

Useful for improvised splinting of fractured limbs to relive pain and assist simple movements.



Basic First Aid Kit.

Contains high energy foods, strappings, bandages dressings and record sheets in a Darren Drum.
